

#### Goals

- →an industry free of fatalities, injuries and occupational diseases
- →safety performance improvement
- →government legislation that supports our industry approach
- →QRC companies directly contributing to, and benefiting from, health and safety improvements as a result of being a member of the QRC.




- → fatalities and risk management

### QUEENSLAND **COUNCIL**

#### Review of Queensland Mines Inspectorate

- →The QRC strongly believes that a well funded, well organised and well supported inspectorate is essential to ongoing safety improvement in Queensland
- →An additional levy on industry is not necessary to ensure this
- →Industry already works in partnership with government to set the pace of safety reform and industry already funds much of the costs of change.





### QUEENSLAND <u>resources</u> council

#### Review of Queensland Mines Inspectorate

- →QRC agrees there should be effective competency-based education and training
- → Need for positive performance indicators
- →Mines Inspectorate should continue to be stand-alone body.





### QUEENSLAND <u>resources</u> council

#### New compliance policy

Current policy should be retained and identify key propositions:

- →safety is paramount
- →entities or persons not willing to make their workplaces safe should be held accountable
- →Employers and employees have responsibilities for safe workplaces
- →Close collaboration between QRC and QMI necessary for effective compliance
- → Policy needs to accurately reflect views of QRC and QMI
