

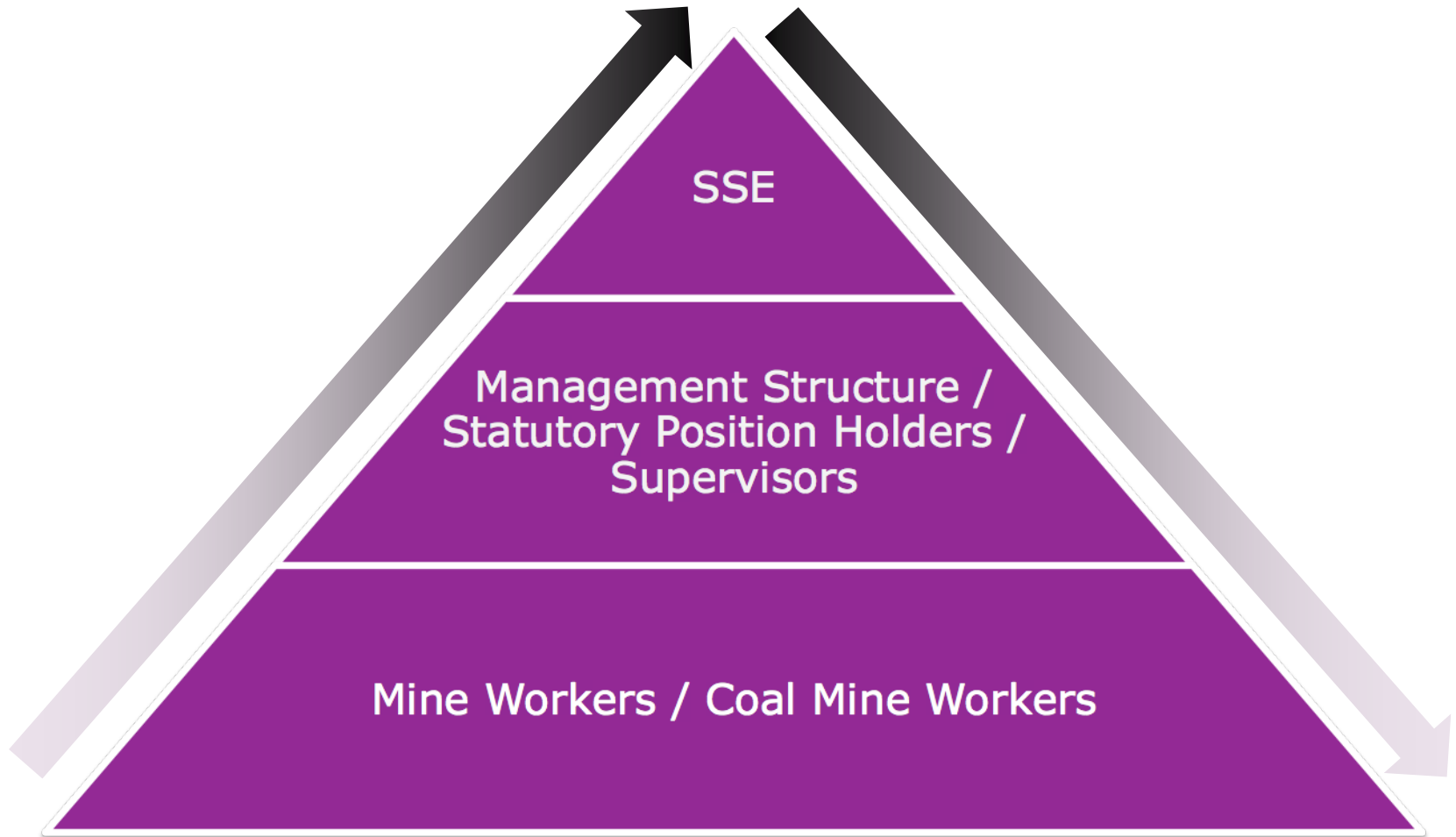

Worker obligations

- Primary duties – contained in section 36 MQSH Act and 39 CSMH Act
- Additional duties set-out in both Acts and Regulations, including:
 - to not destroy, deface or alter the mine record
 - to provide reasonable assistance to an inspector and to comply with the proper exercise of the inspectors powers
 - to not interfere with the site of a serious accident or high potential incident without the permission of an inspector
 - to the extent relevant to their role - comply with the obligations in the Regulation directed at specific types of work



Prosecution of workers

- Maximum penalty
 - \$220K or 3 years in prison
- Defences
- Enforcement considerations
- Key themes from cases
